- Music Review ... Rage Against The Machine! -

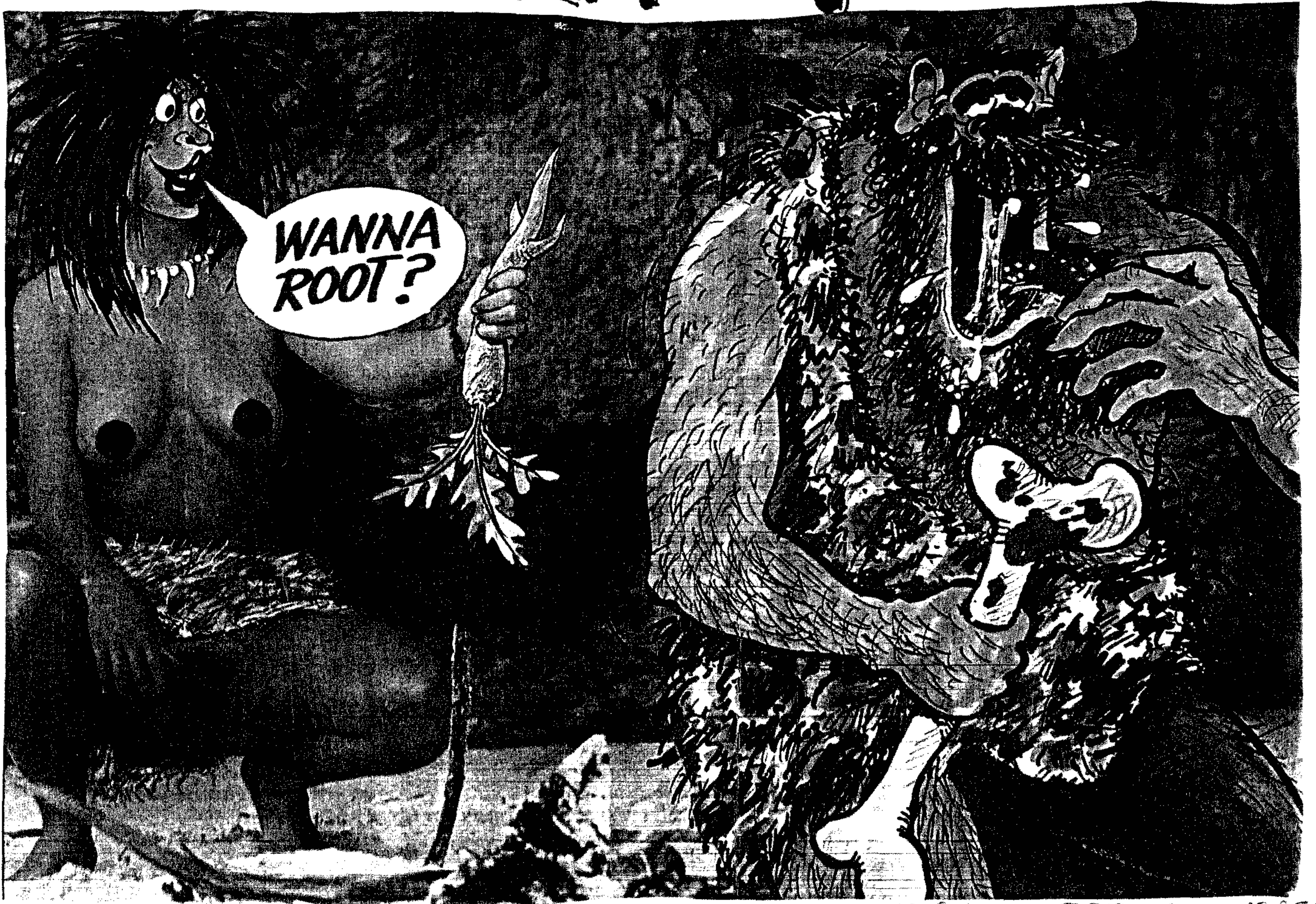

# REVIEW REVIEW

This time we're reviewing the latest issue of Vandalism News, under the BodyCount label...

The intro starts with some heavy freaky music, then a Bodycount logo (in blues & grey) pops up on the blank screen, and when the music builds up you get 'proudly presents' & 'Vandalism News #9...' and below a big scroller. It all looks quite cool when it gets going, and the music suits the style of the intro. So gets the logo flashing off screen and jumps to a flashing instructions screen. The link between this and the menu kept crashing for me (I don't know whether this a bug in the code or just my copy) but after several loads and reloads, I finally got to the main menu... It starts off with a top scroll on a blank screen (it reminds me of the Script menu a bit) and then a green white Vandalism logo on a grey background comes in, after that there's the ISSUE NINE sprites (flashing) the chapters below that, the music is good but doesn't really suit this menu. Anyway, press a chapter key (N) and get to the text displayer...

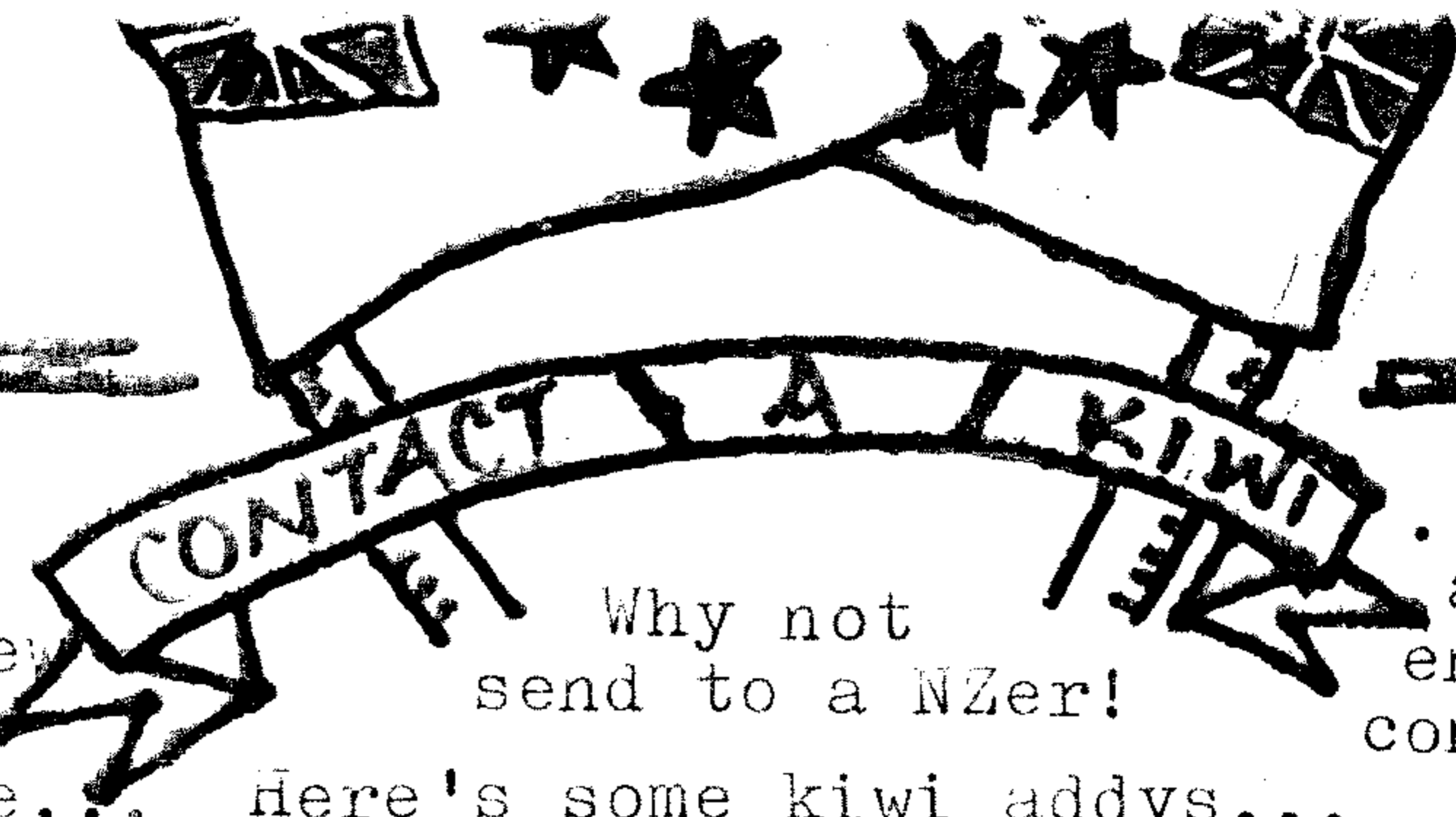
Cool character set (as in menu scroller), with text on the top half of the screen and a cool (!) BodyCount logo on the bottom half of it (one of the best I've seen in an aussie product! Congrats Patto!). ..

The text content is pretty good too, ranging from the usual charts, addies, news, etc to how to make hash & something about epileptic fits from playing computer games, and I don't think any chapter has less than 6-8 pages of text in it...

It's good to see the return of this cool Aussie mag, and I'm sure it will continue to be one of the best mags in our scene under the new BodyCount management.

# REVIEW NUMBER 2

The second review in this month's issue is of a demo called 'Beyond Reality' by a crew called Focus...

The intro is pretty cool, a weird looking Focus log above a small note with letters that shrink and grow at different times to give a ripple effect that is excellent, space has 5 or 6 pages, and then onto the loader bit.. This has a cool B.R. logo (top & bottom) and the credits for the next part come on screen, letter by letter... Next part has a cool piccy of an owl swooping, and 6 little sprite boxes that say FC 93 they twist and turn in all different directions that you can change with the joy-stick.

Part 2 starts with music and a blank screen, then a coolie piccy of Robocop comes on screen, and after that a not-so-cool pic of Darkman. These two keep repeating until you press space, nothing special. The next part is way-kewl with a green plasma (a bit grainy) that you can change the x, y, positions with the joy-stick. An FCS logo below with a pic of a keyboard and the keys light up in time with the music this effect is real cool!

After this, there is probably the worst part of the demo with a pic of a head cut in half on either side and after a while a pic of some fucked up lady come in the middle and starts to swing vertically, there is no scroll here and that is not a very cool way to finish the demo as this is the final part, but I guess that's really up to the makers to decide.

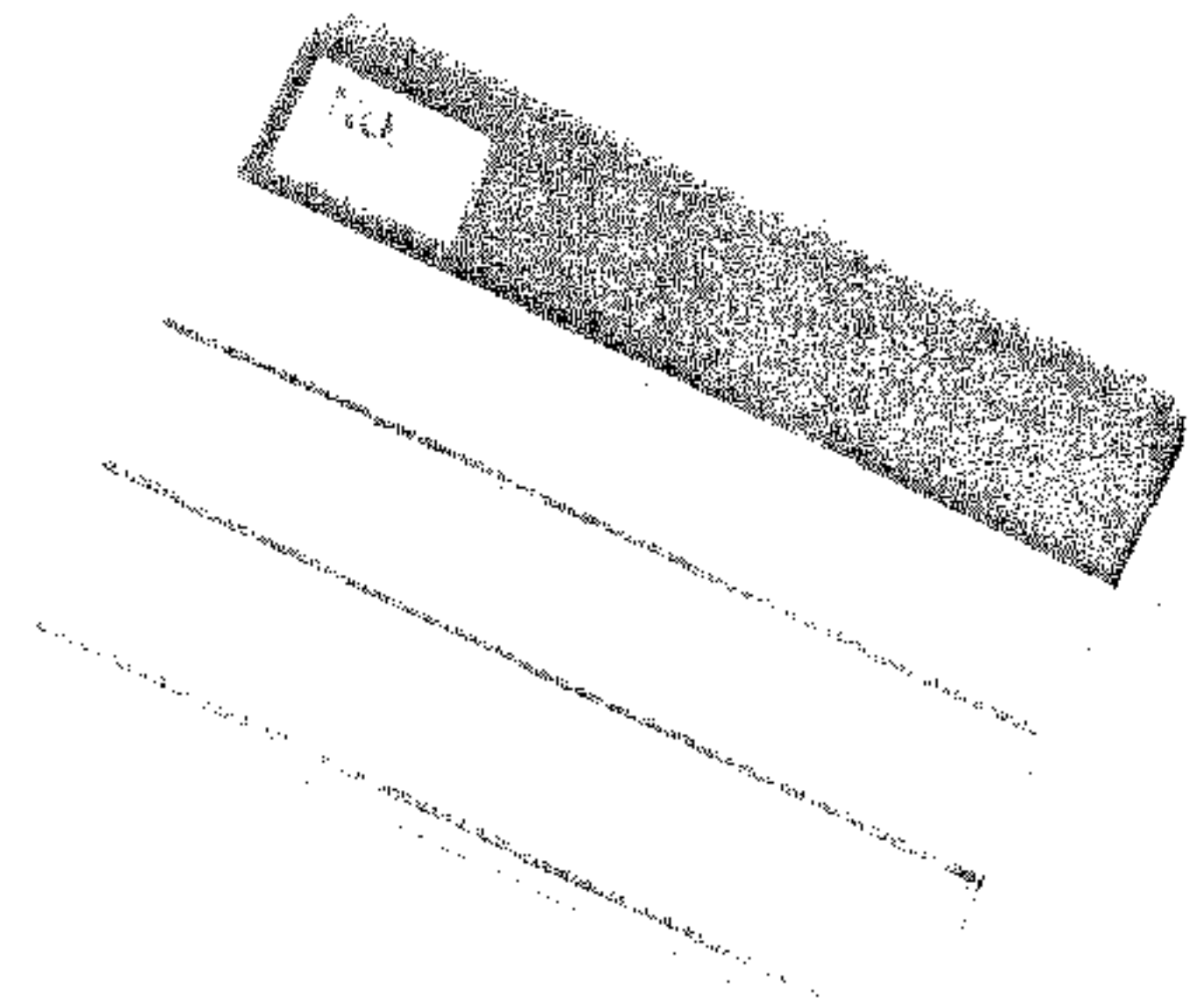

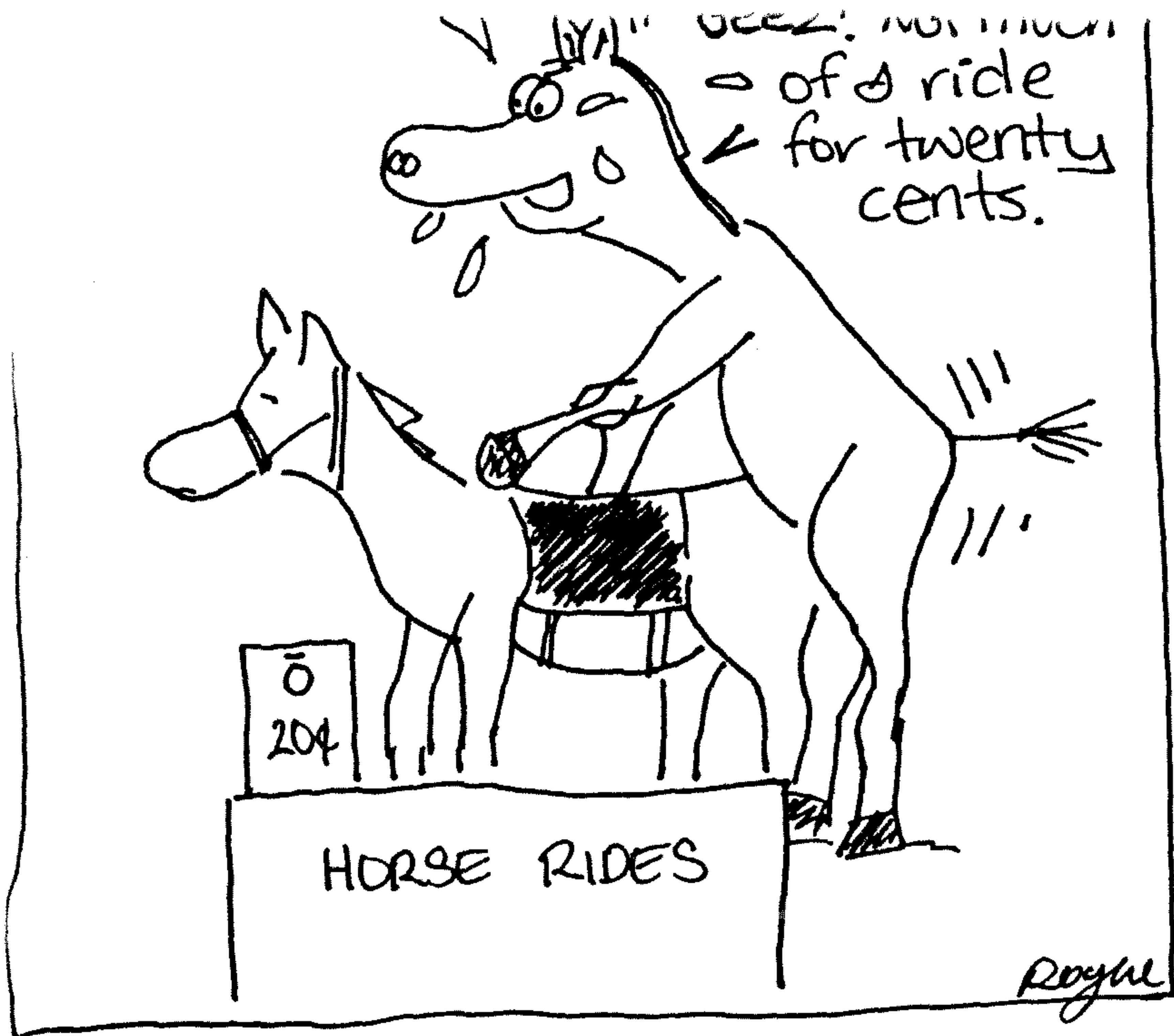
# M I X E D
